What is CEO?

CEO (Creating Entrepreneurial Opportunities) is an entrepreneurship education program that prepares youth, to be responsible, enterprising individuals who become entrepreneurs or entrepreneurial thinkers and contribute to economic development and sustainable communities. The CEO program is much more than a textbook course. Rather, students are immersed in real life learning experiences with the opportunity to take risks, capitalize on opportunities and analyze results.

The CEO Program teaches:

Creativity. Leadership. Entrepreneurship.

Montgomery CEO Program Goals:

- Provide opportunities for students to be engaged, curious and ready to learn
- Cultivate empowered students who succeed in college and in life
- Create lifelong learners and community leaders
- Build a peer-advisor community of creative and enterprising problem-solvers
- Develop a powerful mentoring network of local business leaders
- Provide real-life experience for students
- Inspire and encourage young people to return to their community to live, work, raise families and start businesses

Montgomery CEO Program:

- Is based on a successful program in Effingham, IL
- Is funded entirely by local investors
- Is open to high school seniors
- Uses a rigorous application and selection process, grades are not the defining admission standard
- Meets for 90 minutes each day
- Provides two high school credits
- Visits dozens of area businesses and hosts 50 to 60 guest speakers each year
- Emphasizes 21st century learning skills
- Provides the opportunity for each student to start a business during the school year
- Provides a mentor from the business community for each CEO student
- Hosts an annual trade show to showcase student businesses
- Utilizes businesses as classrooms which allows students from multiple school districts to establish a common identity based on their CEO experience and a greater appreciation for our area's professional work environments

Where You Come In:

Be an Investor

The Montgomery CEO program will be run in partnership with-but independently from Montgomery schools. All program expenses, including the instructor, class materials and transportation, will be paid by private donors. We are seeking 60 investors to commit \$1,000 a year for a minimum of three years.

We need business and community leaders who can connect with the next generation and provide inspiration, motivation and advice.
